Abstracts will be reviewed by a scientific expert panel and will be selected for oral or e-poster

- **Relevance of the research to the conference theme**
- **Scientific quality of the research approach**
- **Quality of the abstract writing**
- **A slight preference will be given to abstracts that summarise completed research compared to ongoing work**

Abstracts should have

- **A title of maximum 20 words**
- **An abstract body of maximum 350 words. The body should include the usual items:**
 - **Introduction**
 - **Materials and methods or methodology**
 - **Results and discussions**
 - **Implications**
- **The 350-word limit INCLUDES up to 3 references, Vancouver style**
