Carcass	Complete post mortem	Small sized animal	Carcass	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Animals should be kept refrigerated/chilled prior to submission if submitted within 48 hours following death.</li> <li>• Animals that would be submitted later than a 48-hours postmortem interval should be frozen.</li> <li>• Small animals intended for necropsy should arrive packaged either in a carrier, box, or bag.</li> <li>• For long transport please include gel ice packs (not wet ice).</li> </ul>
